Subject:

Update on Current Business Operations under the Flooding Condition and **Unusually High Water Level Situation in the Central Thailand**

We would like to update all of our stakeholders on current business operations under the flood conditions and unusually high water level situation in the Central Thailand.

Information

- 1. Two of our three breweries are affected by the flood. The precaution plan is implemented to those breweries in order to prevent potential water damages, including the safety and well being of our employees:-
 - Wang Noi Brewery, Ayutthaya Province: Its operation is temporary shut-down.
 - Bang Baan Brewery, Ayutthaya Province: There is still partially operating to produce some drinking water to serve the water consumption shortage.
 - Kamphaeng Phet Brewery, Kamphaeng Phet Province: It is still in full operation for beer production to meet market demand.
- 2. Most of our finished goods from Wang Noi and Bang Baan Breweries are being transferred to our operational warehouses in unaffected areas.
- 3. Our distilleries and non-alcohol beverages facilities including the DC and local warehouses which are located in other regions of the Country are still functioning and operating normally.

Financial Effects

4. The effect of this incident will depend on the extent of damage and the amount of recovery from the insurance claims. In this regard, our industrial all risk (IAR) insurance policy covers damage to breweries including corporate and movable assets caused by flood, and business interruption (BI) insurance policy covers the loss of income during such period.

Others

5. For impact to Oishi Group Public Company Limited, the information will be available on the website of the Stock Exchange of Thailand ("SET") (http://www.set.or.th) once the upload by Oishi via SET website is completed.



At this point in time, we are unable to determine how long the flooding condition and unusually high water level will remain. In case that there is any material impact to our operation, we will keep you informed.
